Student Achievement Data

Each spring, all public schools in the state of Missouri are required to administer the state achievement MAP (Missouri Assessment Program) test. The MAP test is given in the areas of Communication Arts to students in grades three through eight, and grade eleven; Math to students in grades three through eight, and grade ten.



Student performance on the MAP is reported in terms of four performance or achievement levels: Advanced, Proficient, Basic, and Below Basic. These scores are a means of comparing test results with standards of academic performance as established by a state panel drawn from education, business, and professional communities.
