With the health and wellbeing of our students, staff, and community in mind, the Governor of Missouri announced this afternoon that no Missouri public schools will reopen for in-person classes for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. However, meal service and eLearning will continue for Moberly School District through the remainder of the school calendar. We will share more details about this next week.
