



Moberly School District FALL 2020 SURVEY RESULTS

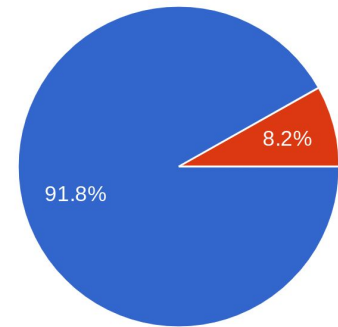
We received over 1,100 responses to an initial survey for parents and guardians to express their preferences on how students return to school this fall. Through this feedback, we learned that the overwhelming majority wants school to go “back to normal.” Many shared concerns about social distancing, wearing masks, and social-emotional health of our students. District administrators will work diligently to provide “normal” while implementing layers of protection for students and staff.

If students are to return to buildings for school in the fall, will your child attend?

1,126 responses: 91.8% Yes 8.2% No

Based on survey information, the district currently plans to provide traditional in-seat instruction beginning August 25; however, because this is a fluid situation the plan for instructional delivery could change quickly. In school, students will be encouraged to practice social distancing as much as the setting will allow, and procedural modifications to the “normal routine” will be implemented as needed to provide multiple layers of safety such as:

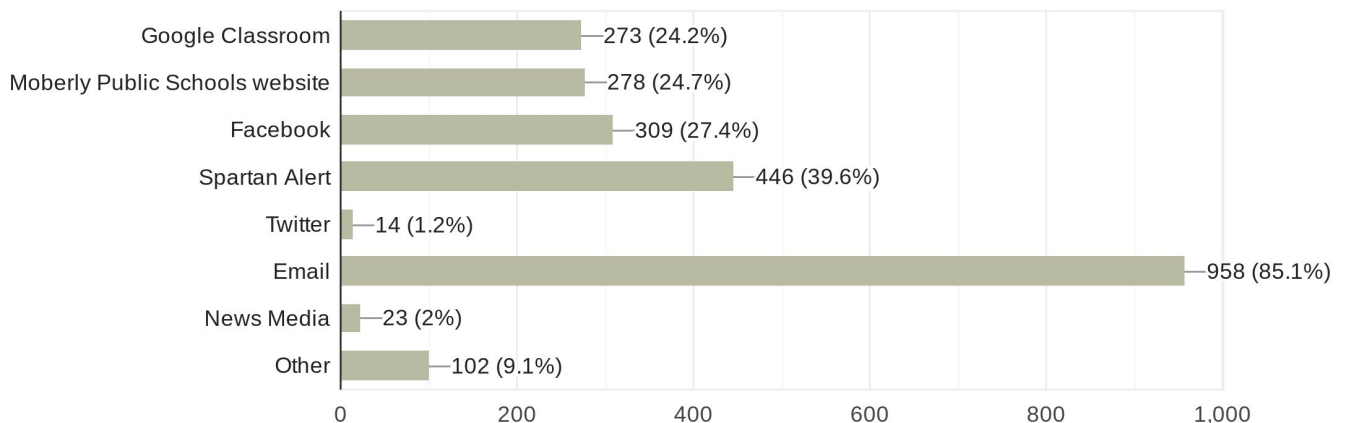
- temperature checks upon arrival
- staggered schedules to lessen hallway/lunch traffic
- use of masks and other PPE as recommended
- scheduled times for handwashing throughout day
- additional sanitizing throughout the day in high traffic areas
