


TO PREVENT COVID/QUARANTINE: WEAR A MASK, STAY IN SCHOOL




If your student is properly wearing a mask IN SCHOOL and comes into contact with a positive covid case who was properly masked, they can attend school if they remain symptom free.

Wearing of masks by all staff and students eliminates the need to quarantine close contacts as long as both individuals (vaccinated and unvaccinated and the person who tested positive for Covid-19) were properly wearing a mask during EXPOSURE AT SCHOOL, and the close contact is not exhibiting symptoms. Individuals testing positive for Covid-19 must isolate at home. Students exposed without symptoms can attend school, but NO EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



TO RESPOND TO COVID POSITIVE: QUARANTINE OPTIONS



Is your student considered a close contact WITH SOMEONE OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL OR IN SCHOOL WITHOUT A MASK, and has to quarantine?

According to Randolph County Health Department guidelines, individuals who are considered **close contacts** will now have three options on how to quarantine.

**FULL 14 DAY
QUARANTINE**

Information from the health department will include the full 14 day quarantine at home and monitor for symptoms.

Student may return to school after their full 14 days of quarantine and remain symptom free.

OR

**Alternative
OPTION #1
10 DAY
QUARANTINE**

Student may return to school on day 11 (after 10 days of quarantine) and being symptom free.

Student will need to monitor for symptoms, continue to **wear a mask at all times** and socially distance days 11-14.

OR

**Alternative
OPTION #2
7 DAY + NEGATIVE
TEST RESULTS**

If a student is symptom free for 7 days of quarantine, they may be tested on day 5 or after (**from an approved testing site, RCHD, or medical provider**) Home tests will not be accepted.

Student may return to school on day 8 if the test result is negative, **Negative test result must be provided to the school before returning.**

Student must monitor symptoms, continue to **wear a mask at all times** and socially distance days 8-14.
