



2020 Fall Spectator Information

In an effort to provide the opportunity for students to participate in activities and create the safest environment for our students and their families, the NCMC Conference has implemented the following guidelines for attendance at activities at member schools for the Fall activities season:

- Live streaming of games/contests/performances will be used when possible to reduce attendance at events to allow spectators to view events if they are unable to attend in person.
- Fans are expected to sit with their families during contests and social distance from other fans.
- Fans are required to wear face coverings while in attendance.
- Fans are not allowed to leave and reenter the event venues.
- School superintendents will determine each District's tier level/color on Monday of each week and it will be in effect at each performance/event from Tuesday-Monday. The North Central Missouri Conference (NCMC) has developed a process in which this will be determined to minimize confusion or hardships on parents and other spectators.
- Student Sections will be determined by each school district.
