



Moberly School District Climate Survey results continue to drive improvement

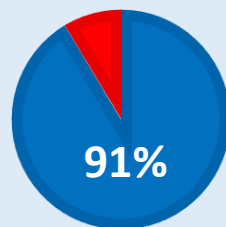
In the Spring of 2017, our community participated in the District Climate Survey. More than 1600 Spartan students (grades 5-12), parents, and staff completed the survey and voiced their thoughts and feelings about school climate in the Moberly School District. We know positive school climate promotes lower drop-out rates, higher teacher satisfaction, and decreased incidence of violence—all leading to a meaningful school experience and strong academic achievement in our district. Gathering input from parents, students, and staff is critical to improving school climate at the Moberly School District.

Strengths

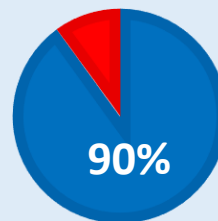

Moberly parents believe that the school staff cares about their child and provides a sense of belonging

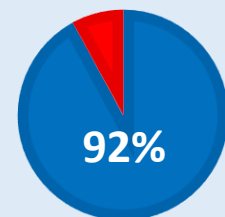
I FEEL WELCOME AT THIS SCHOOL



AT THIS SCHOOL, MY CHILD FEELS HE/SHE BELONGS

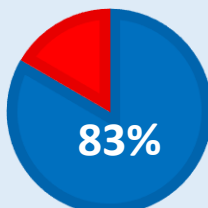


AT THIS SCHOOL, THE STAFF REALLY CARES ABOUT MY CHILD

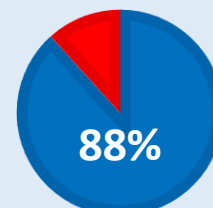


Students have many opportunities to participate in class and are noticed

IF I AM ABSENT, THERE IS A TEACHER OR SOME OTHER ADULT AT SCHOOL THAT WILL NOTICE MY...

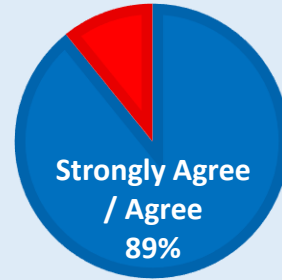

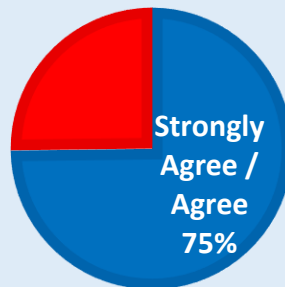


Opportunities For Growth

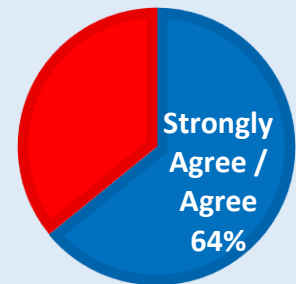
Our climate survey has given us opportunities for growth too! We want all students to take part in decision making about their school and value their learning.
